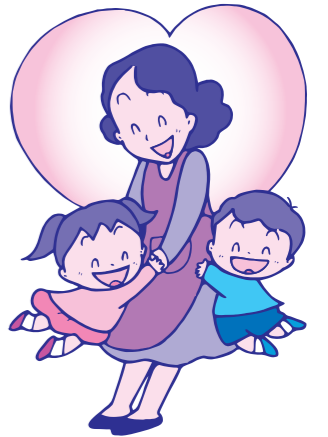

### Home visitation for your baby

A Public Health Nurse or Midwife will visit your home. They will check your child's height and weight and do a care consultation.

 \* If you have the checkup outside of Ishikawa Prefecture, only part of the checkup cost will be subsidized.

If your child had a medical condition that required a long-term recuperation and he/she couldn't get the vaccination in time, then please consult the Health Center.  
 People who have not been inoculated 3 times, and were born between 4/2/95~4/1/07, and are under 19 years old can receive the Japanese Encephalitis vaccination.

## Child immunization cost subsidies

Available for these vaccinations

- Mumps, Influenza, Rotavirus, Hepatitis A/B
- Only if you were inoculated with any vaccine after the suggested inoculation period.

Amount: Each time up to 1000 yen (Up to 2 times per year per vaccination type.)  
 Age: Birth ~ third year junior high school  
 Application acceptance period: From within one year following the month of vaccination date.  
 Send application: To the Health Center

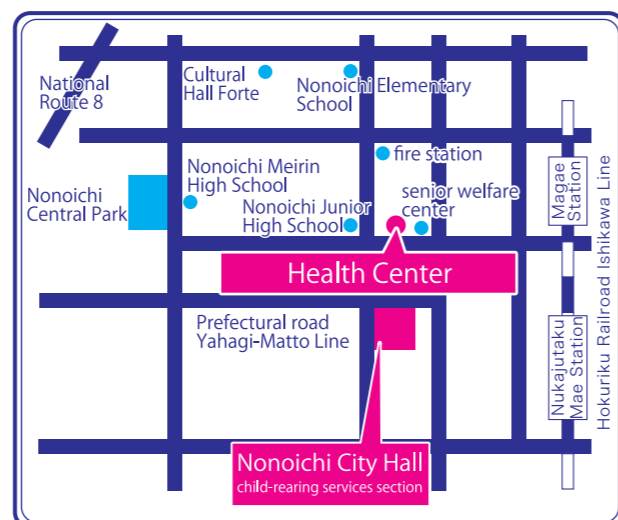

# Important Dates for Your Child's Healthy Growth

Your baby's body begins with a single cell and grows to 3 trillion cells before birth. Then, the cells increase to 60 trillion in a full-grown adult. The foundation of your baby's body is important for healthy growth. Through classes and individual consultations, let's work together to think about how you can spend your pregnancy to give your baby a solid foundation for healthy growth.

## Class for expecting mothers and fathers

Class location: Health Center

The mother's body is connected to the baby's body. During pregnancy, women's bodies change in ways that can and cannot be seen, such as the quantity of blood and hormonal changes, as well as the size of the abdomen. Together, let's think about important points, such as how to interpret checkup results so that both baby and mother can maintain a healthy life.
