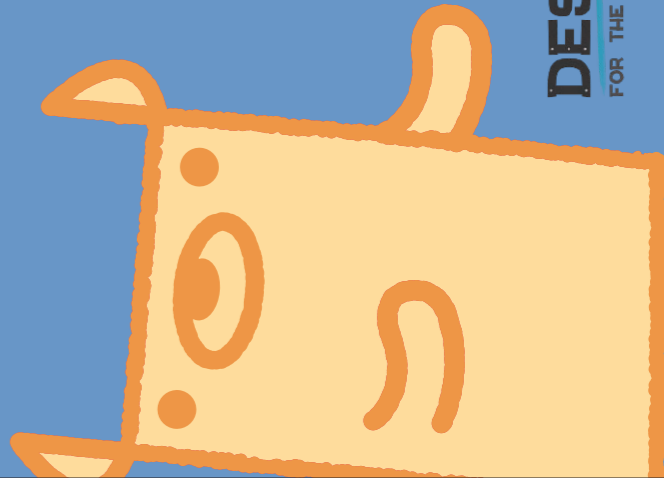

Earthquake Response & Emergency Procedures

- ① Avoid danger and stay safe.
- ② Extinguish fire outbreaks.
 - Don't attempt to put out fires that are out of control.
- ③ Locate and secure an exit.
- ④ When evacuating, walk and remain calm.

Be sure to:

- Wear a helmet or hat.
- Carry a backpack with essentials.
- Secure possible fire hazards.
- Switch off the breakers.
- Take only what you need.
- ⑤ Avoid narrow alleyways and rivers.
- ⑥ Beware of potential landslides.
- ⑦ Work together to provide first aid to others.
- ⑧ Stay informed and beware of possible aftershocks.

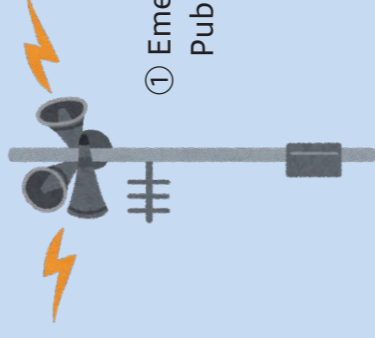

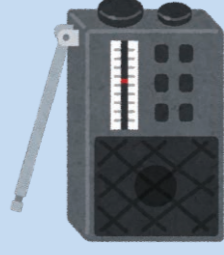

Evacuation Procedures

Evacuation is a key preventative measure to staying safe in dangerous situations. Please evacuate to a secure location when:

- The city, police, fire department or neighborhood organizations issue an evacuation warning.
 - Buildings are at risk of collapsing.
 - A fire breaks out at home and reaches the ceiling.
 - A fire breaks out in your neighborhood and there is a risk it will spread to adjacent houses.
- Any time it is dangerous to go outside, please remain indoors.

Home

Go to the temporary evacuation area

This is an emergency assembly area for use in the event of a disaster. Locations of shelters have been determined according to neighborhood zones.

Go to the base shelter

These facilities provide safety and basic necessities. In preparation for earthquakes (with a seismic intensity of 5 or greater), shelters have been stockpiled with emergency supplies such as food and blankets.
