Preparing for an Earthquake

- Tightly secure freestanding furniture with brackets and bolts to stable walls or pillars.
- Prepare a plan of where to meet family members and friends.
 - Keep in touch with your neighbors and establish contacts with people whom you can ask for help.
- Locate your nearest evacuation area.
 - Identify the location of the nearest park and school.
- Assist those who may need additional help, such as children or elderly people.
- Register your personal information with your embassy.
 - Once registered, you can receive announcements from the embassy and use their online safety confirmation system.

Earthquake Response & Emergency Procedures

- 1. Avoid danger and stay safe.
- 2. Extinguish fire outbreaks.
 - ✓ Don't attempt to put out fires that are out of control.
- 3. Locate and secure an exit.
- 4. When evacuating, walk and remain calm. Be sure to:
 - ✓ Wear a helmet or hat.
 - Carry a backpack with essentials.
 - ✓ Secure possible fire hazards.
 - ✓ Switch off the breakers.
 - ✓ Take only what you need.
- 5. Avoid narrow alleyways, cliffs, and rivers.
- 6. Beware of potential landslides.
- 7. Work together to provide first aid to others.
- 8. Stay informed and beware of possible aftershocks.



Evacuation Procedures


Evacuation is a key preventative measure to staying safe in dangerous situations. Please evacuate to a secure location when:

- 1. The city, police, fire department or neighborhood organizations issue an evacuation warning.
- 2. Buildings are at risk of collapsing.
- 3. A fire breaks out at home and reaches the ceiling.
- 4. A fire breaks out in your neighborhood and there is a risk it will spread to adjacent houses.

Any time it is dangerous to go outside, please remain indoors.

Go to the temporary evacuation area

This is an emergency assembly area for use in the event of a disaster. Locations of shelters have been determined according to neighborhood zones.



Go to the base shelter

These facilities provide safety and basic necessities for everyday life. In preparation for earthquakes (with a seismic intensity of 5 or greater), shelters have been stockpiled with emergency supplies such as food and blankets.

Additional shelters

Shelters are to be used in the event of a large scale disaster or when there are many evacuees.

Welfare shelters

These are shelters for individuals, such as the elderly, who may require special care or assistance.
